



Adobe Dreamweaver The Basics Course Outline



Course aims:

Delegates will learn how to create a Web site by importing and formatting text and images, adding links, creating tables, using frames and uploading the site to a remote Web server. You will also learn about the basic concepts of the Internet and the World Wide Web.

Pre-requisites:

Before taking this course, delegates should be familiar with the basic functions of their computer's operating system. Ideally you should also have basic word processing skills, such as copying and pasting text, formatting type, and so on.

Who should attend:

This course is designed for those who wish to learn how to create Websites using Dreamweaver. To attend this course you must be familiar with the basic operation of the Windows operating system. An understanding of basic HTML would be an advantage although not essential.

Duration: 1 day or 2 days

Getting started	Understanding the internet and html, exploring the Dreamweaver environment, examining the panels, working with documents
Designing a site	Creating sites, working with the site panel and site maps
Creating and enhancing web pages	Creating, enhancing and formatting web pages. Checking spelling, importing text
Connecting web pages	Linking pages, creating links by using named anchors, linking to web sites and email addresses
Image maps	Using image maps, creating hot spots, alt tags for hot spots
Working with images	Inserting an image in a document, adding background images, creating links by using images
Working with tables	Adding and formatting tables, resizing cells and tables, using tables to design web pages
Using styles and style sheets	Cascading style sheets, cascading characteristics, applying style sheets, exporting style sheets, attaching external style sheets, using css selector classes, eliminating underlines from links
Uploading site	Remote and local views, getting and putting files, checking in and checking out, testing servers
