



Adobe Dreamweaver for the Expert User Course Outline



Course aims:

Delegates will learn how to create a Web site by importing and formatting text and images, adding links, creating tables, using frames and uploading the site to a remote Web server. You will also learn about the basic concepts of the Internet and the World Wide Web.

Pre-requisites:

Before taking this course, delegates should be familiar with the basic functions of their computer's operating system. Ideally you should also have basic word processing skills, such as copying and pasting text, formatting type, and so on.

Who should attend:

This course is designed for those who wish to learn how to create Websites using Dreamweaver. To attend this course you must be familiar with the basic operation of the Windows operating system. An understanding of basic HTML would be an advantage although not essential.

Head elements and meta tags	Defining head elements, understanding meta and other tags, inserting tags with the meta object, refreshing a web document
Creating forms	Form elements, laying out forms, setting methods 'post' and 'get', form handling
Using libraries	Organising a library, creating and modifying library items, detaching or deleting a library item
Introduction to rollovers	Swapping images, adding and modifying behaviours, flash text and flash buttons
Working with templates	Template overview, creating templates, applying templates to pages
Working with layers	Creating and drawing layers, positioning and measurement of layers, modifying and moving a layer, the 'drag' behaviour layers and behaviours, using show/hide layers
Timelines and animations	Using the timeline inspector, adding layers to the timeline, selecting and inserting key frames, changing layer properties over time, animating layers using the timeline
Working with behaviours	Attaching a behaviour to the entire document, attaching a behaviour to an object, modifying a behaviour, redirecting users based on the browser they are using, displaying status messages
Browser targeting and good practice	Testing your page with a targeted browser, Dreamweaver's target browser check, testing browser compatibility for an entire site, good web design practice
