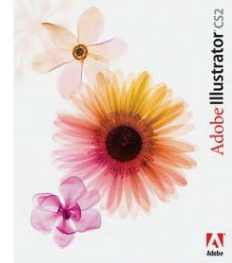


Adobe Illustrator The Basics Course Outline



Course aims:

This course enables delegates to be able to produce a broad range of images for newsletters, product leaflets, adverts, posters and sales material for either internal use or for commercial printing

Pre-Requisites:

Delegates must have a good knowledge of the Windows operating system and should be familiar with standard word processing features.

Who should attend:

This course is intended for those who need to use Illustrator to create illustrations, logos, advertisements, or other graphic documents.

Overview	The Illustrator environment, navigation
Creating a simple illustration	Create a new document, basic shapes, manipulate shapes, export an illustration
Using colour	Apply colour, stroke options, the eyedropper tool
Drawing paths	Raster images, basic drawing, selecting and editing paths
Working with text	Adding text, altering text
Working with fills and colours	Swatch libraries, gradients, transparency
Working with layers	Layers, naming layers, manipulating layers
Working with advanced type features	Using the tab ruler, using advanced type features
Saving, importing and exporting files	Saving files in native formats, importing files, exporting to other file formats
